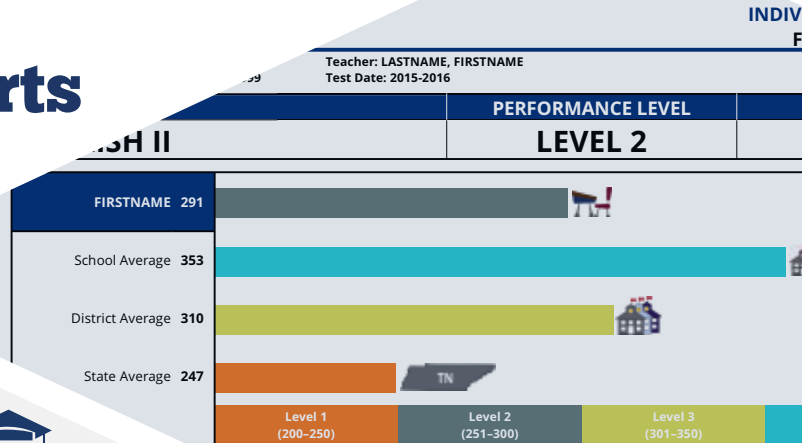

The TNReady report has INFO TO ACT ON!

The TNReady report tells you whether your child is on grade level and how your child is performing compared to other students in their school, district, and state.

It also offers **specific guidance** on the next steps to help your child continue learning.

You can **take this report to your child's teacher and have a discussion** about your child's progress in school.

Some questions to begin that conversation:

- What do these test results tell you about what areas my child needs help in?
- What do you recommend as next steps to help my child learn more?
- How can I support the learning happening in your classroom in my home?
- What are some things I can look for during the year to make sure my child is on track?
